



Impact of the Care Provider Alliance's Membership

The 11 national professional associations which make-up the Care Provider Alliance represent all types of provider organisations that deliver care and support to over 1,185,000 people in England who use residential, home-based and community services. The Alliance estimates that its members deliver £390.8 million of care services each week, employing over 623,500 careworkers.

Notes:

The Care Provider Alliance (CPA) is the group of leading provider associations which represent independent and not-for-profit providers of social care services.

CPA members' services include residential and nursing care, homecare, supported living and extra care housing, shared lives schemes, advocacy and telephone helplines. People who use CPA members' services may be older people, working age adults or children.

Membership of CPA is open to representative associations with a national membership across the whole of England, although a number of CPA members also represent services in other UK administrations.

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
