Better Security, Better Care

[Better Security, Better Care](#) is a national and local support programme run by Digital Social Care to help adult social care providers to store and share information safely.

It covers paper and digital records and focuses on helping care providers to complete the Data Security and Protection Toolkit – the annual, online self-assessment.

The Better Security, Better Care Local Support Partners is working with their local partners and networks to ensure that the support they offer fits in the best way locally.

The programme includes NHS England Regional Leads, Ageing Well Teams and the Association of Directors of Adult Services (ADASS). The NHS England regional leads are linking into Integrated Care Systems and ADASS is supporting with links to local councils.

Intelligence Function Peer Learning Group

1. A network of systems, across the country, involved in the day-to-day delivery of an ICS Intelligence Function (IF), covering common obstacles and solutions
2. A regular forum for individuals to access when they require peer support and networking opportunities. Particularly relevant to those in analytical and business intelligence leadership roles
3. System led sessions recognising that each system is at a different stage of maturity in building their Intelligence Function
4. Feedback from members requested bimonthly, recorded sessions and close alignment with design and development of IFs
